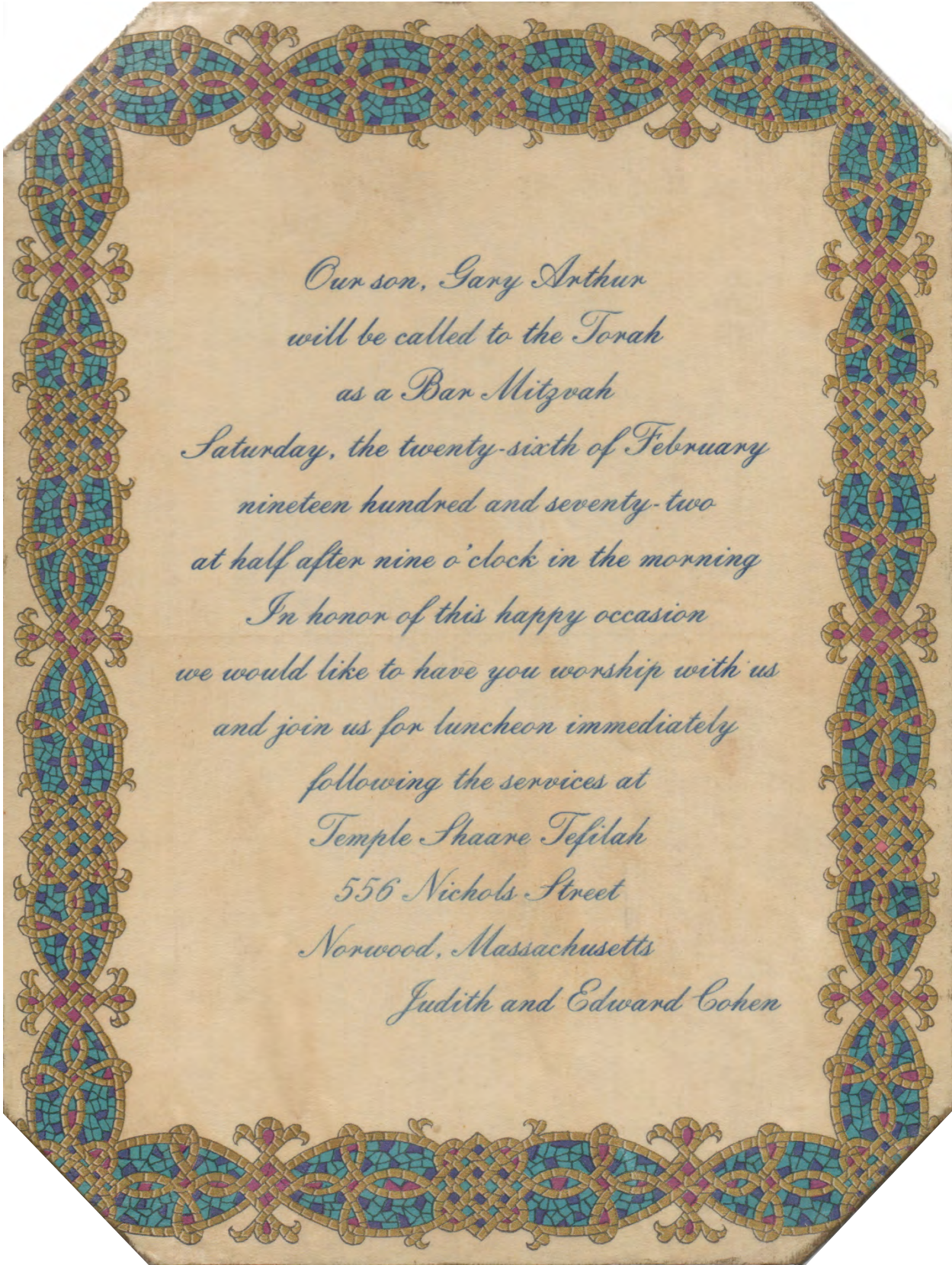




*Our son, Gary Arthur
